

The Finishing School

Certain players always seem to be in the right place at the right time in position to score, and goalies seem to never stop their shots. These traits are acquired through repetition, hard work, and PRACTICE. Unfortunately, these skills are not always taught to every lacrosse player. 1. Shooting with time and room
2. Shooting on the run
3. Finishing on the crease
4. Scoring off of a successful dodge
5. Lacrosse IQ and field vision

Brian Bishop: Former Greensboro College player and coach. As a coach at GC, Brian was an offensive assistant and ran the man-up team. Brian was a NCAA DIII Final Four participant in 2005 while playing for Roanoke College. In 2009 he was a Greensboro College Captain, leading the team in man-up goals and helping GC tie the single season record for wins. Brian was named 2nd team All-State as a senior at Northwest Guilford (2004).

Billy Blakely: Current player with the Charlotte Hounds. Billy is the Greensboro Director of LB3 and offensive assistant with Greensboro College. As a player, Billy led Greensboro College with 33 goals and 23 assists in his senior season (2012); he tallied 11 points in one game, and eclipsed 100 points during his collegiate career. He was selected to the USILA All-Star game (2012). He was a Queen City Top 50 All-Star from Charlotte's Hopewell High School (2008).

Randall Brooks: Former Greensboro College player. Randall owns the GC record for assists in a single game with 8. He was a two-time 1st team All State midfielder from Southeast Guilford (2005 & 2006). Randall holds the North Carolina single season record for scoring as a midfielder (2006).

Maxx Aiken: Former Greensboro College player. Maxx was a four-year starter at the midfield position and finished with 32 goals and 17 assists. In 2009, Maxx was name 1st team All State, All American and was crowned South Carolina Player of the Year at Camden Military Academy.
